ASEAN Hub, Malaysia - The ASEAN Hub based in Malaysia is working with key partners in the region to develop student and staff exchanges, research collaborations, and programme development. In July 2016 Bournemouth University's first ever global Festival of Learning took place at one of the ASEAN Hub's key partner locations in Kuala Lumpur.

Connect India Hub, India - Connect India brings together a team of dynamic researchers, educators, practitioners, students and alumni at BU with their counterparts in India to focus on interdisciplinary collaborations in three key areas of initial focus: media, management, and social care.

China Innovation Hub, China - Working with the Chinese Government, and partners across education and industry, the China Innovation Hub will create global impact by co-creating global innovation networks through conducting high quality research, providing strategic consultancy, and be-spoke executive development. The hub is initially focusing on the areas of: triple helix innovation, digital innovation in health and big data, creative production and computer animation, disaster management and cyber innovation, intellectual property, and new energy.
